Title of the Practice: Voluntary Blood donation Camp

Objectives of the Practice: The primary aim of our voluntary blood donation initiative is to raise awareness about the critical need for blood donations and to support the less fortunate members of our community. Our secondary objectives include fostering a culture of altruism and maintaining a comprehensive database of voluntary blood donors. Additionally, we strive to educate the community about the positive impact of voluntary donations and discourage the harmful practice of collecting blood from paid donors.

The specific sub-objectives are as follows:

1. Sensitize individuals to the importance of timely blood donation for those in need.
2. Cultivate a sense of responsibility and empathy by encouraging individuals to contribute to the gift of life.
3. Motivate students to pledge to donate blood at least once a year.
4. Instill the value of blood donation and its impact on community health.

The Context: The need for blood is growing by the minute. It is essential in emergencies such as accidents and operations, as well as in the treatment of chronic illnesses such as cancer and the like. The altruistic act of donating blood regularly is a beautiful human gesture. The message is that giving blood willingly is a vital way for individuals to display their concern or care for the lives of others. Blood donations are generously required in huge quantities from regular, healthy, willing donors in this fast-paced lifestyle. Providing the necessary quantity of blood from all groups at all times, even during odd hours, to hospitals and PHCs in a rural community is a wonderful humanitarian gesture. Life is priceless, but preserving a life is endearing. The message is that giving blood willingly is a vital way for individuals to display their concern or care for the lives of others. Blood donations are generously required in huge quantities from regular, healthy, willing donors in this fast-paced lifestyle. Providing the necessary quantity of blood from all groups at all times, even during odd hours, to hospitals and PHCs.

The Practice: The IQAC and NSS department of the College collaboratively organize the Blood Donation Initiative, scheduled for 02-03-2022, coinciding with the birthday celebration of Dr. Dhavalsinh Mohite-Patil. This event is conducted in partnership with Akshay Blood Bank Solapur and Shivshambho Charitable Trust, Karmala. The college provides all necessary facilities, including space, furniture, blood group testing rooms, and a blood donation area adhering to medical standards. The camp commences with a motivational session by subject experts, enlightening students about the significance of this impactful practice.

Before donation, student donors undergo screening to ensure the quality of the blood collected. Individuals who are underweight or infected are advised against donation based on medical guidance. Donors are educated about the rejuvenation of their blood cells with each donation, promoting youthfulness in their blood. Scientific information about blood groups and associated diseases is shared with the donors. The inaugural meeting, led by the principal, precedes the blood donation camp, which witnesses active participation from staff, alumni, and

51 students, resulting in the collection of 28 bottles of blood. Certificates of appreciation are awarded to all 28 blood donors by the blood bank.

Evidence of Success: The initiative has fostered a positive and supportive atmosphere among the less privileged sections of society. Donor students receive free health check-ups, including pulse rate, blood pressure, body temperature, and hemoglobin levels. Certificates of appreciation are presented to donor students, and those in need of medical advice receive proper guidance from health personnel. The camp receives acclaim from stakeholders, including the blood bank, as evident from the following successes:

1. Surpassing the targeted number of student blood donations.
2. High appreciation from college trustees, parents, and other institutions.
3. Encouragement from the charitable trust and Blood Bank staff to organize more such camps in the future.

Problems encountered and Resources required: Challenges encountered include the health ignorance of students from villages and economically disadvantaged backgrounds, needle and blood testing phobia, and instances of malnutrition leading to underweight and anemic students. Addressing these challenges requires targeted health education programs, psychological support, and nutritional interventions.
