Blood Donation Camp and Road Safety Week Celebration

Introduction: On the auspicious occasion of Hon. Dr. Dhawalsinh Mohite-Patil's birthday, a revered trustee of our college, organized a significant event encompassing a Blood Donation Camp and the celebration of Road Safety Week. Blood Donation Camp: A dedicated area was set up for the Blood Donation Camp, equipped with medical facilities and staffed by trained professionals. 


